Hello Kindergarten Families! The following is a list of topics your child should practice over the Summer to get their minds ready for the start of Kindergarten in September!

- Writing their name independently
- Being able to recognize all letters of the alphabet and their sounds (uppercase and lowercase) Using magnetic abc letters is one way to practice this and make it a game!
- Practicing writing all of the letters of the alphabet (Uppercase and lowercase) ((There are many free worksheets online that can be helpful for this! Even using a whiteboard and dry erase marker at home if handy!))
- Recognizing numbers 1-20 and practicing writing them. (There are also many free worksheets online that will be helpful for tracing/writing numbers).
- Knowing how to use scissors independently, and how to hold them safely.

- Knowing their colors
- Knowing their basic shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle, etc.)

- ABC mouse (free app on the ipad great for both Math and ELA)
- FRECKLE (free app on the ipad also great for Math and ELA)
